Oconto County can vaccinate those that meet 1 or more of the eligibility criteria below:

- Child is 18 years of age or younger and is enrolled in Medicaid/BadgerCare
- Child is 18 years of age or younger and does not have health insurance
- Child is 18 years of age or younger and is an American Indian or Alaska Native
- Child is 18 years of age or younger and is underinsured (has health insurance that does not pay for vaccinations)
- TD/Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis-whooping cough) available to anyone who is uninsured or who has insurance coverage that does not fully cover the vaccine (including certain Medicare plans)
- Individuals ages 19 and older who are uninsured or underinsured may be eligible to receive certain vaccines based on medical history.

****Adults with Medicaid are considered insured and therefore would not be eligible to receive state supplied vaccine at the Health Department****
